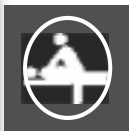

Finding The Right Chiropractor

On the first visit, let the doctor know your individual concerns. The doctor should openly respond to any questions. He should give you realistic expectations. Advanced adjusting techniques, modern equipment and adjuncts to chiropractic such as acupuncture, exercise and/or nutrition are standard acceptable care.
